Recovered Stolen Vehicle: On February 4, 2020, at 8:59 am, a Detective located an unoccupied stolen vehicle in the 76 Gas Station (828 Willow). The Honda CRV was partially stripped and had a false plate on it. The vehicle was stolen in Vallejo, in December 2019.

Found Property: On February 4, 2020, at 10:24 am, an Officer located a suspicious vehicle on Bayfront near Railroad. The 2005 Pontiac had a rear license plate that belonged to a 2006 Pontiac. The plate was collected to be returned to DMV.

Warrant Arrest/ Felon in possession of a loaded firearm: On February 5, 2020 at approximately 12:34am, Officers stopped a white Dodge Caravan in the area of 3900 San Pablo Ave for a traffic violation. The 41 year old male passenger, of San Francisco, had an active misdemeanor warrant out of San Mateo County. The warrant was confirmed by dispatch and Williams was taken into custody. During a pat-down search, after the subject was detained on the warrant, an Officer located a loaded black handgun in his waistband. The subject has a criminal history with felony convictions. The subject was booked into the Martinez Detention Facility on multiple gun related charges. The female adult driver was released with a traffic citation.

Domestic violence: On February 5, 2020 at approximately 4:12am, Officers were dispatched to the 2100 block of Lupine Rd. for a report of a domestic disturbance. Officers contacted the adult male victim in the front yard of the residence. The victim had cuts, scratches and bruising to his face and cuts on his upper chest. The victim stated his 47 year old wife attacked him while he was sleeping. The suspect threw a box of cosmetic products at him and punched the victim in the face. The female was taken into custody for Felony Domestic Violence and later transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. An Emergency Protective Order was granted for the victim.
