Dog Bite Report: On March 4, 2020, at 1:38 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to the 1500 block of Swallow for a five year old juvenile who was just bitten on the face by a dog. Officer arrived on scene, along with Rodeo Hercules Fire Department, and administered first aid. The dog was quarantined in the yard for Animal Control. The juvenile was transferred to Children's Hospital.

Accident: On March 4, 2020, at 2:07 pm, an accident occurred on Refugio Valley Road, near the Senior/Junior High School parking lot, between a 2013 Honda and a 2011 Cadillac. One party complained of pain to their chest but declined to be transported by ambulance. He said he would drive himself to the hospital.

Grand Theft: On March 4, 2020, at 5:17 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 400 block of Sparrow Drive for a theft report. The reporting party he received a call from Antioch PD stating they had detained a subject who was in possession an IRS refund check, in his name, and advised him to contact the Hercules PD for a theft report.
