Found Property: On March 11th 2020 at approximately 4:48PM a HPD Officer took a case for a found backpack in the 100 block of Iris Road.

Domestic Violence: On March 11th 2020 at approximately 6:12PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 1000 block of Valley Run for a domestic disturbance. It was determined that victim was punched, several times, by (S) an adult male who fled the scene prior to Officer's arrival.
