Vandalism: On March 18, 2020, at approximately 12:18 pm, an Officer was dispatched to Bio Rad security office located on Linus Pauling for a reported vandalism. Sometime around 8:00 am this morning, a vehicle caused damage to Bio Rad property by driving recklessly on the property. The security department was able to provide a vehicle license plate, and said they could identify the driver. The Officer is conducting follow up on the case.

MSIN: On March 18, 2020, at approximately 4:47 pm, Officers were dispatch to the 1000 block of Chelsea for a man with a gun call. The RP stated the father of her child threatened to harm himself. Officers arrived on scene and the subject, a 24 year old male of Hercules was not located. After conducting an extensive search, Officers were able to determine the subject was out of the area. An officer was eventually able to make phone contact with the subject who told the officer he was fine but did not want police contact.

Reckless/ Suspended Driver: On March 18, 2020, at approximately 10:06 pm, an Officer conducted an enforcement stop on a vehicle spinning donuts in the 3500 block of Franklin Canyon Rd. The driver, a 24 year old male subject of Richmond was determined to have a suspended driver's license. He was admonished for the reckless driving and cited for driving while his driving privileges were suspended. The vehicle was left parked at the scene.
