**Package Theft:** On May 27, 2020, at about 8:00 am, an officer was dispatched to a residence in the 400 block of Grenadine Way for a reported package theft. The victim told the officer his package was delivered and confirmed via USPS. The victim arrived home and located his mailbox open, and the package was gone.

**Outside Assist:** On May 27, 2020, at about 8:38 pm, Officers responded to the area of Victoria Crescent East and Craftsman Drive to assist Contra Costa County Sheriff's Deputies with a pursuit collision. CCCSO requested a courtesy report for the suspect vehicle that collided with a tree. The suspect was not injured and was taken into custody.

**Non-Injury Vehicle Collision:** On May 28, 2020, at about 9:27 pm, Officers were dispatched to the area of Hercules Ave and San Pablo Ave for a collision between a WestCat bus and another vehicle.

**Evading:** On May 27, 2020, at about 10:57 pm, Officers were notified of an ALPR hit of a carjacking vehicle (black 2014 Mercedes E550) in the area of E/B I-80 and Appian Way. The vehicle was located on E/B I-80 near Willow Ave. The driver of the Mercedes immediately attempted to elude Officers as soon as they realized Officers were behind them. A pursuit was initiated and the Mercedes reached a top speed of 110 MPH. The pursuit was terminated when Officers lost visual just past the toll plaza. Nearby agencies were notified.
