Hit & Run: On June 1, 2020, at about 9:21 pm, an Officer was monitoring vehicles exiting E/B I-80 at Hercules when he saw a 1995 Honda Accord exit the freeway. The Accord's front bumper was hanging off the front of the vehicle and the vehicle appeared to have recently been involved in a collision. A traffic enforcement stop was initiated in the 1500 block of Sycamore Ave. The driver was identified as a 32 year old male from Hercules. He was found to be on PRCS and had a suspended/revoked driver's license. He denied being involved in a vehicle collision however, Dispatch contacted CHP and confirmed this was a suspect vehicle in a hit and run vehicle collision that just occurred on E/B I-80 at Appian Way. CHP was unable to respond so an initial investigation was completed as an outside assist to be forwarded to CHP.

Coroner's Case: On June 1, 2020, at 11:34 pm, Officers were dispatched to a residence in the 1100 block of Waverly Circle for a report of a 60 year old male having a heart attack. Upon arrival, Officers located the subject lying on the floor of the upstairs common area. Rodeo-Hercules Fire responded and pronounced the subject deceased. There was no evidence a crime was committed, and the Coroner released the body to his family.

Possession of a Controlled Substance/ Warrant Arrest: On June 2, 2020, at 3:10 am, an Officer did a traffic enforcement stop on a 2004 Chevy Monte Carlo on Willow Ave near Hawthorne for a vehicle code violation. The driver was identified as a 34 year old male subject out of Stockton. An Officer observed drug paraphernalia. A probable cause search of the subject produced a small amount of a controlled substance in his pant pocket. The subject was also determined to have an outstanding Misdemeanor Warrant for embezzlement issued out of Alameda County. The subject was cited and released for being in possession of a controlled substance and for the Warrant
