Auto Burglary and Poss. of Burglary Tools: On June 5, 2020, at approximately 12:01 am, Officers were dispatched to a residential alarm in the 400 block of Violet Rd. As Officers arrived on scene, they observed a Hispanic female adult exit the interior of a Ford pickup and run into an awaiting silver Honda Accord. The vehicle was last seen toward Lupine Rd. Another Officer located the Accord on Lupine Rd and Heather Ave and conducted an investigative detention. The driver was identified as a 33 year old male and the passenger was identified as a 38 year old female. Both subjects were from San Rafael. The passenger admitted to attempting to steal items from the Ford on Violet Rd. Both subjects were placed under arrest. During a search of the female subject, multiple shaved vehicle keys including one for Ford vehicles was located on her person and where she was seated. The owner of the Ford was contacted and confirmed his vehicle was locked but was unsure of any take. The female was transported to CCRMC by ambulance due to complaints of shortness of breath prior to being booked into MDF. The male subject was released per PC 849 and the vehicle was towed.

Warrant Arrest: The female subject was also taken into custody for an outstanding warrant for theft related charges out of Alameda County.

Identity Theft: On June 5, 2020, at approximately 10:32 am, an officer was dispatched to a residence in the 100 block of Civic Drive for an Identity Theft report. The victim stated that someone used her identity to withdraw money she received from her stimulus check from her checking account.

Grand Theft: On June 5, 2020, at 4:04 pm, an officer was dispatched to a residence in the 100 block of White Cap Cove for a reported theft of a catalytic converter from a 2007 green Prius.

Miscellaneous Information: On June 5, 2020, at about 6:05 pm, Officers were dispatched to a residence in the 100 block of Paradise Drive for a reported verbal family dispute. A case was taken to be forwarded to Child and Family Services.

Warrant Arrest: On June 5, 2020, at approximately 9:46 pm, an Officer conducted a traffic enforcement stop. The driver, a 28 year old female was determined to have an outstanding warrant for prostitution held by Santa Ana PD and was cite/released.

Identity Theft: On June 6, 2020, at about 9:16 am, an officer was dispatched to a residence in the 100 block of Pearce Street for a reported identity theft. The victim reported that in December of 2018, an unknown suspect opened an AT&T account in his name and left a bill for \$200.00.

Felony Vandalism: On June 6, 2020, at about 3:46 pm, officers were dispatched to the 76 Gas Station located at 828 Willow Ave for the report of a female inside the store who was

knocking things over. Officers arrived on scene and determined a male came into the business without a mask and asked to use the restroom. He was refused for not having a face covering on. He started to yell at the clerks calling them racist, and then a female came into the business and asked to buy cigarettes. She was also denied service because she did not have a face covering on. She responded by yelling and knocking over the flower and fruit displays. The clerks estimated the damage at approximately \$500.00.

Solo Motorcycle Collision: On June 6, 2020, at approximately 11:40 pm, Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Marigold for a motorcyclist down. Officers arrived and located a 30 year old male subject on the ground breathing but not responsive. It appears the subject low sided his 2018 Harley Davidson Sportster and came to a stop when he struck the rear of a parked vehicle. Officers rendered first aid until Fire/AMR arrived on scene. He was air lifted to John Muir Walnut Creek.

Stolen Vehicle – Moped: On June 7, 2020, at about 9:23 pm, an Officer was flagged down near the Aventine Apartments regarding a stolen moped. The victim told the Officer that an unknown suspect stole his Silver '09 Tomos Spirit sometime between 06/05/20, at 10:00 pm, and the time of call. The Moped was parked on Tsushima St. at Riverview Terrace. An area check was done, but no evidence was located. The Moped was entered into SVS by Dispatch.

Warrant Arrest/Possession of a Controlled Substance: On June 8, 2020, at about 2:00 am, an Officer conducted a pedestrian stop on a male on a bicycle on San Pablo Ave at John Muir Parkway. The male was identified as a 25 year old male subject out of Vallejo. He was found to be on PRCS for Arson and had an outstanding No Bail Warrant for violating PRCS. During a parole search of his person, an Officer located 3.4 grams of a suspected controlled substance in the subject's pant pocket. He was cited out on the possession of a controlled substance charge and was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility for the warrant.
