## WATCH COMMANDER'S SHIFT REPORT

**Stolen Vehicle:** On June 18, 2020 at approximately 8:27 am an Officer was dispatched to the 800 block of Forest Run for a stolen vehicle report. The victim reported that sometime between June 17, 2020, at 8:00 pm, and June 18, 2020, at 7:30 am, an unknown suspect stole his white 2005 GMC Savana 2500 Van.

**Warrant Arrest:** On June 18, 2020 at 3:32 pm, Officers working County Vehicle Suppression Enforcement Team conducted a traffic stop and contacted 43 year old female, out of El Sobrante. The subject had a \$35,000 warrant out of Contra Costa County. She was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Miscellaneous Case:** On June 18, 2020 at 4:49 pm, a 15 year old female juvenile came into the lobby of the police department stating she was being abused by her mother and step-father. The juvenile was interviewed along with the mother, step-father, and two other juvenile brothers. At this time it is unfounded on abuse and Children and Family Services was notified. It was agreed the juvenile would stay with another relative.

**Warrant Arrests:** On June 18<sup>th</sup> 2020 at approximately 8:18PM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop in the area of San Pablo Ave and Linus Pauling Dr. The 37 year old male driver was cite/released on a warrant held by San Mateo County. The 32 year old female passenger was taken into custody on a non-citable warrant, held by San Francisco. She was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Lost Property:** On June 19, 2020, at 9:18 am, an officer was dispatched to the 1900 block of Railroad Ave for the report of a lost wallet. The Reporting Party lives in San Diego and was here over the weekend. When he got home, he realized he misplaced his wallet and the last place he had it was the restaurant on Railroad.

**Natural Death:** On June 19, 2020, at 10:32 am, officers were dispatched to the 300 block of N. Wildwood for the report of a subject in cardiac arrest. Officers arrived on scene with fire and CPR was started. At 11:17 am, the 64 year old male was pronounced deceased. The subject reportedly had diagnosed medical issues.

**Warrant Arrest/Cite:** On June 20, 2020 at 12:58am, an Officer conducted a traffic stop for a stop sign violation. The 21 year old female driver, of Richmond, was found to have a misdemeanor warrant in King County. The subject was cited and released.

**Stolen Vehicle:** On June 20, 2020 at 10:52 am, an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Crestridge Ct. for the report of a stolen vehicle. The victim stated that sometime between June 19, 2020, at 6:30 pm, and the time of call his blue 1998 Jeep Cherokee was stolen.

**Hit and Run:** On June 20, 2020 the victim stated that between June 19, 2020 at 9:00 pm, and the time of call, an unknown suspect hit her vehicle parked in front of her house.

**Hit and Run:** On June 20, 2020 at 2:54 pm, an officer was dispatched to San Pablo Ave. and Sycamore Ave for the report of a hit and run. The victim stated they were in the number two lane northbound San Pablo Ave when the suspect vehicle, an older Brown Toyota Corolla, decided to go from the number 1 lane (left turn pocket) and proceed to eastbound Sycamore as the light turned green. The suspect vehicle's right rear tire hit the left front bumper of the victim vehicle.

**Missing Person Located:** On June 20, 2020 at 9:44 p.m. An Officer was flagged down in the 800 block of Willow Ave. by a 34 year old male requesting assistance. The male was found to be a missing person reported to SFPD on May 22, 2020. He walked away from a Hospital in S.F. The subject was transported, by AMR, to County Hospital and removed from the Missing and Unidentified Persons System.

**Collision:** On June 21, 2020, at approximately 10:42 am, HPD Officers were dispatched to 100 block of Pierce for a collision where a vehicle struck a house. Officers arrived, and found a 2004 Lexus, facing in a northwest direction into the southeast side of a residence. The 66 year old female driver, and solo occupant of the vehicle, was present and uninjured. The driver stated she had some flowers in the front seat and the vase fell over. She leaned over to grab the vase and her vehicle drove over the west sidewalk and into the southeast corner of a house. No one in the residence injured. Public works came out and assessed the residence for safety of the structure. The front room of the residence was yellow tagged.
