Auto Burglary: On June 29, 2020, at approximately 8:28 am, an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Watermark Terrace for an auto burglary. Sometime, between June 26 at 5:00 pm, and June 29 at 8:28 am, an unknown suspect entered a locked 2014 Chevrolet Silverado which was parked across the street from the residence. The suspect stole approximately some keys which.

Warrant Arrest: On June 29, 2020, at approximately 8:39 am, an Officer checked on a suspicious vehicle in the 100 block of Linus Pauling. The 49 year old male occupant had a misdemeanor traffic warrant. He was issued a citation with a new court date, and released.

Burglary: On June 29, 2020, at approximately 3:02 pm, an Officer was dispatched to Valley Bible located at 1477 Willow Avenue for a burglary from a shed. Video indicated two unknown race males wearing hoodies; and driving a vehicle similar to an older model Toyota 4-Runner, drove in the parking lot around to the back of the property. This was at approximately 2:00 am on June 29, 2020. The suspects pried open a locked shed, and stole a chain saw, a generator, and a maintenance tool.

Warrant Arrest: On June 29, 2020, at approximately 2:35 pm, an Officer contacted a 39 year old male at 800 Willow Avenue. The subject had an outstanding felony warrant. He was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Theft from Unlocked Vehicle: On June 29, 2020, at approximately 3:18 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Maritime Terrace for a theft from a vehicle. Sometime between 12:00 am and 1:30 am, on June 29, 2020, an unknown suspect entered an unlocked 2018 Kia parked in the driveway of the victim's residence and took an ear protective device.

Theft by False Pretense: On June 29, 2020, at approximately 3:32 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Maybeck Lane. The victim had contacted what she thought was a Apple support site for some issues she was having with her Apple phone. The victim allowed the technician to remotely charge her \$949.00 for some issues she was having with her phone. The victim later tried to get her money back, and was unable to get it refunded back. It appears the company was fraudulent.

Petty Theft: On June 29, 2020 at 7:37 p.m. An Officer was dispatched to a phone detail regarding a theft of a FasTrak device that occurred sometime between October 2019 and today. The reporting party believes an unknown suspect stole her FasTrak device from her Gray '02 Porsche Carrera. The reporting party contacted FasTrak regarding her stolen device and learned there have been \$425.00 in unauthorized charges to her credit card.

Expired Driver's License/Possession of a controlled substance/Possession of drug paraphernalia: On June 30, 2020 at 5:42 a.m. An Officer did a traffic stop on a Maroon '93 Toyota Corolla on Hercules Ave. at San Pablo Ave. for no front plate, expired registration

(January 2017), and 4463 VC (2020 year tab). The 54 year old male driver, of Richmond, had a pipe, commonly used to smoke narcotics, in plain view near the ashtray. A probable cause search was done and a coin size plastic baggie, with suspected narcotics, was found inside a cigarette box in the subject's pocket. The subject also had an expired driver's license.
