**Auto Burglary:** On July 13, 2020, at approximately 7:29 am, an Officer was dispatched to Home Depot for an auto burglary. Sometime between 6:51 am and 7:21 am, an unknown suspect broke into the locked truck box of a 2012 Ford, F-150 Pick-Up truck, which was parked near Bank of America. The suspect stole miscellaneous tools.

**Shoplifting:** On July 13, 2020, at approximately 8:10 am, HPD Officers were dispatched to Rite Aid for a theft that just occurred. The store manager reported a 35 year old female, known to the store, had just stolen two bottles of beer from the store and was walking away. The description of the female matched a suspect Officers had just contacted, regarding food she stole, at Lucky Market. Officers located the suspect and beer was located in her bag. Rite Aid wished to press charges, and subject was arrested and transported to Martinez Detention Facility.

**Vandalism:** On July 13, 2020, at approximately 5:32 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Turquoise for a female banging on the door. Officers arrived and determined two neighbors have been fighting with each other for years, and today one neighbor threw some tree branches over the fence and broke some garden ornaments in the backyard of the other resident. The resident, with the damage, wanted to press charges. A case was taken.

**Warrant Arrest:** On July 13, 2020 at 10:32 p.m. An Officer did a traffic stop on a Black '03 Honda Accord for no front license plate. The 23 year old male driver was found to be on Parole, and had an outstanding, cite releasable, Misdemeanor Warrant. The Warrant was issued on June 29, 2020. **Warrant Arrest:** On July 14, 2020 at 5:32 a.m. An Officer did a traffic stop on a Black '19 Nissan Sentra, for speeding.
