Possession of Controlled Substance for Sale/Possession of Drug Paraphernalia/Parole

Hold: On July 21, 2020, at approximately 8:46 am, an Officer stopped a white Honda Civic Coupe, with no license plates, at Taco Bell. The 40 year old male driver, of Rodeo, was on searchable Parole in Contra Costa County. An Officer located a small amount of a substance, believed to be a narcotic, and a glass pipe commonly used to smoke narcotics, on the subject's person. The Officer located more of the substance, believed to be a narcotic, in a computer bag inside the vehicle. The subject was arrested, and his Parole Officer authorized a parole hold. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Warrant Arrests: On July 21, 2020, at approximately 9:35 am, an Officer stopped a 2005, Lincoln for expired registration. The 34 year old male driver had two warrants; one Misdemeanor warrant out of Napa, and one felony warrant out of Solano County. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Vandalism: On July 21, 2020, at approximately 9:45 am, an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Beechnut for vandalism. Sometime between July 16th, at approximately 10:00 pm, and the time of the call, an unknown suspect cut the main power line and brake lines to a construction trailer that was parked in the driveway.

Outside Assist – Vehicle Fire/Arson: On July 21, 2020 at 11:47 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the BART Transit Lot, 1375 Willow Ave. for a suspicious person. An anonymous reporting party stated they saw a man near the road holding something in his hand. Upon arrival, Officers found a Black '02 Kia Spectra on fire and fully engulfed. The vehicle fire spread to the grass to the rear of the Transit Lot near E/B SR-4. Rodeo-Hercules Fire responded and extinguished the vehicle fire and the fire that spread towards SR-4. BART PD responded to take over the vehicle fire/arson investigation.
