**Driving Under the Influence and Hit and Run:** On July 30<sup>th</sup> 2020 at approximately 8:26PM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop. The 23 year old female driver, displayed the objective symptoms of being under the influence of alcohol intoxication. She was placed under arrest after performing the Standard Field Sobriety Test. The Preliminary Alcohol Screening device indicated the subject was over the presumptive limit for the purposes of driving... It was also determined that she was the suspect of a non-injury hit and run, in the 800 block of Willow, Ave just moments before Officer's contacted her. The victim positively identified the driver and the vehicle during an infield show up and wished to press charges. The subject was cite/released to a responsible party.

**Occupied Stolen Vehicle Recovery:** On July 31<sup>st</sup> 2020 at approximately 12:40AM a HPD Officer located a stolen gray 2013 Ford F150 in the 800 block of Willow Ave. The sole occupant, a 38 year old female, was detained. The victim was contacted and it appears the two have some sort of "relationship". The victim was not able to take possession of his vehicle so it was towed away. The subject was released pending review of the case by the DA's Office.

**Vehicle Burglary:** On July 31<sup>st</sup> 2020 at 7:06 am officers contacted a 47 year old male, Richmond resident, walking on Hwy 4 carrying a golf club. Officers checked Franklin Canyon Golf Course and found a vehicle, which was broken into, but were not able to locate the owner. The subject said he found the golf club on the side of the freeway. The subject was provided a courtesy transport to Richmond. It was later determined the vehicle was broken into on July 30, 2020, between 4 and 8 pm, however the owner had not reported it. A computer, and passport were taken, but no golf clubs.
