**Domestic Violence Restraining Order Violation/Resisting Officers with Force:**

On August 4, 2020, at approximately 4:54 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to the 2000 block of Lewis Street for a restraining order violation. The, 39 year old male, reporting party was waiting in the back of the house. The reporting party said his, 25 year old male, partner may be inside the house. The reporting party had a valid Emergency Protective Order against his partner. Officers checked the residence and located the suspect in the kitchen. The suspect was very uncooperative with Officers, and would not comply with commands. The Officers attempted to detain the suspect in handcuffs, and he began physically resisting the Officers. He continued to resist and to try and pull away from Officers. Officers were finally able to get him in handcuffs. The Officers arrested the suspect for the Court Order violation. The Officers walked the suspect to a patrol car, and he began trying to pull away again, and fighting with the Officers. The suspect was finally restrained, and transported to the County Regional Medical Center, for medical clearance, prior to being taken to the Martinez Detention Facility. In addition to the Court Order Violation the suspect was charged with Resisting Officers with Force. Officers sustained several minor abrasions on their hands and forearms.
