**Lost or Stolen Plate:** On August 6<sup>th</sup> 2020 at 11:57 am an officer responded to the 100 block of Armstrong for a lost or stolen plate. The reporting party stated that sometime, within the last year, the plate from her Jet Ski trailer was either lost or stolen somewhere between Hercules and Lake Berryessa.

**Petty Theft:** On August 6<sup>th</sup> 2020 at 2:40 pm, an officer responded to the 1200 block of Devonwood for a citizen who located several articles of mail. The officer found a package and mail had been stolen from Ben Lomond and Lompico.

**Identity Theft:** On August 6<sup>th</sup> 2020 at approximately 7:46PM a HPD Officer took a phone report for an identity theft case. The victim stated someone used her information to obtain unemployment benefits.

**Warrant Arrest:** On August 6<sup>th</sup> 2020 at approximately 11:30PM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop. A 25 old male, of Richmond, was cite/released for a warrant.

**Probation Violation and Poss. of controlled substance:** On August 6<sup>th</sup> 2020 at approximately 11:55PM a HPD Officer contacted a 44 year old male, in the 800 block of Willow Ave. He was determined to be on searchable probation. During a search, a substance, suspected to be a narcotic, was discovered in his property. He was cite/released at the scene.

**Warrant Arrest:** On August 7<sup>th</sup> 2020 at approximately 3:13AM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop. The 64 year old male driver was taken into custody on a warrant. He was cite/released at the scene.

**Harassing Phone Calls:** On August 7<sup>th</sup> 2020 at 8:29 am, an officer was dispatched to the 1100 block of S. Shelter Bay for the report of a harassing phone calls. The victim said a subject, in Southern California, is continually calling, and harassing her, after she has told him to stop

**Violation of Court Order:** On August 7<sup>th</sup> 2020 at 3:06 pm, an officer was dispatched to the 1300 block Sycamore Ave Apt. for a violation of a court order (Child Custody). The 41 year old father of the child, of Hercules, is not returning the child to the mother on the scheduled court ordered visitation days. Officers attempted contact the father via phone and the house and there was no answer.

**Miscellaneous:** On August 7, 2020, at 7:20pm, officer went to a Hercules residence for an accidentally discharged a firearm inside his house. The bullet lodged into the floorboard. No occupants were injured.

**Warrant Arrest** On August 8<sup>th</sup> 2020 at approximately 1:36AM a HPD Officer checked on a suspicious vehicle. The 33 year old male occupant was taken into custody on a citable warrant. He was cite/released with a new court date.

**Theft:** On August 8<sup>th</sup> 2020, at 7:00pm, an officer took a theft report. The theft was from an unlocked silver Accord parked in the 1100 block of Forest Run. The crime occurred on August 5, 2020, but was not reported. Today, Concord PD made an arrest, of two people, in possession of the R/O's property. CPD handled the arrest and requested we take the original theft report for documentation.

**Missing and Returned Adult Person:** On August 8<sup>th</sup> 2020, at 7:23pm, officers were dispatched, for a missing 29 year old male, to the 100 block of Pearce. The subject was located, a short time later.

Officers contacted a 17 year old female who stated her 18 year old boyfriend punched her in the face last night. He then locked her in a room and would not let her leave.
