**Identity Theft:** On August 11, 2020, at approximately 4:40 pm, an Officer handled a lobby detail for an identity theft. A Hercules resident received a message through "What's App" approximately one month ago. The person sending the message said he could help the victim improve his credit score. The victim provided all of his personal identifying information to the suspect. The victim recently found out several credit cards have be fraudulently opened in his name and now have balances totaling over \$50,000.00.

**CRIME PREVETION TIP: Do not provide personal information to unsolicited e-mails, texts, or phone calls. Most of the unsolicited messages, or calls, are SCAMS. If you give out your personal information you may become the victim of a fraud.**

**Warrants:** On August 11, 2020, at 8:28pm, officers were dispatched to the Franklin Canyon Golf course parking lot for a male refusing to leave. Officers arrived and contacted an adult male, who said he was stranded. He had two misdemeanor Contra Costa County warrants. He was cited and provided a ride to his neighborhood in Crockett.
