**Possession of Stolen Vehicle/Possession of Controlled Substance:** On August 19, 2020, at approximately 9:22 am, an Officer stopped a white, 2001, Chevrolet Camaro, with no license plates on it. The Officer checked the VIN and the vehicle came back stolen out of Richmond. The Officer detained the 39 year old male driver. The subject was arrested, and transported to Martinez Detention Facility. Prior to going into the jail the subject admitted to having narcotics hidden on his person. A substance, believed to be a narcotic, was located in the subject's possession.

**Found Property:** On August 19, 2020, at approximately 11:24 am, an Officer handled a lobby detail for found property. A resident found a set of keys including three brass keys, one silver key, and key chains that had an umbrella, palm tree and a Golden Gate Bridge. The keys were found in the city hall parking lot, and later booked for safekeeping at HPD.

**Warrant Arrest** Officers were dispatched to a residence in the 1900 block of Pheasant Dr for an unwanted person. Officers discovered the person in question was a 15 year old male juvenile. He was determined to have a non-citable Juvenile warrant. The juvenile was placed under arrest and transported to Juvenile Hall.
