

# NEW ALL-DAY Dynamite Crew Distance learning Hub

**Welcome to Dynamite Crew!** To start camp follows all of the State and County Health Department requirements including: daily temperature checks, frequent hand sanitizing, everyone needs to wear masks, and no contact drop-off & pick-up. Camps have limited space. Enrollment is contingent upon our ability to staff the pods, meet the minimum age appropriate enrollment number, and the completion of all registration paperwork, including payment in full for each block registered.

\*REFUNDS: There will be no refunds unless the City must cancel because we cannot staff, or don't get the enrollment minimums. In which case a full refund will be given.

## Dynamite Crew—distance learning support Hub

**Locations:** AM-Teen center & PM Hanna Kidz Center.

This is a support lab meeting at the Teen center for distance learning and Afterschool fun at the Hanna Kidz center. We will take the City vans to Hanna after 2:15pm when school over for the day. This is a little bit of both worlds school and hanging out with friends.

Staff will assist participants with their blended learning experience. Parents must provide classroom schedule(s), and your own classroom supplies i.e. laptop/chromebook, headphones, pens/pencils, textbooks, paper to accomplish your assignments, etc. We will provide a staff assistance, safe environment, and socialization with peers. The PM is all about recreation getting outside playing group games and chilling with friends. Bring your own snack /lunch/snack/water bottle. We will take breaks throughout the day. Each bubble will be in age appropriate groups. Regardless of the wide range of grades that sign-up. Location may change due to enrollment.

**Note we will continue with programs starting January 11, 2021; we anticipate a new Health Order from the State and County. We will modify guidelines whenever the Health Services order makes changes.**



**Dynamite Crew is for 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> graders only.** This is a “3” week block camp with the same group of 14 per pod. We call these blocks “color bubbles”. Camp must have minimum enrollment of 10 participants for each program. You will need to send two healthy snacks and lunch in a plastic or brown paper bag daily. Camp is **Nut Free Zone**. This camp is a distance learning support hub till the end of the school day and recreation activities in the PM. Participants must provide all of their classroom supplies including i.e. laptop/chrome book, headphones, textbook, and assignments to be completed. There must be clear direction from parents on daily assignments and extra work or a book for school “quiet time”. The PM is for exciting activities with friends. We will take City vans from the Teen center to Hanna every day. See permission slip form in packet.

# CAMP POLICIES ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AGREEMENT

Check -after reading.

- Credit Card Payment:** Payments must be paid by the due date for each block. You can pay by filling out a credit card sheet or online/over the phone. Plus a 24 hour mail slot for checks only. If payment not paid by due date we will need to move to the next person on the waiting list.
- Billing Issues:** The City of Hercules will not contact any other person except the parent or guardian on the registration form regarding billing issues. Staff cannot accept payments at the Centers. Community Swim Center hours Monday-Thursday 9:00am-5:00pm, contact number 510.799.8290/8291. Due to the Shelter-In- Place order the office is closed but you can reach us by calling office or emailing us.
- Enrollment:** is contingent upon our ability to staff the pods, meet the minimum age appropriate enrollment numbers, and the completion of all registration paper work, including payment in full for each block.
- Cancellation:** will not be permitted during the three week block sessions nor refunds. A medical exception may be made on a per case basis. If we cancel the program you would receive a credit/refund.
- Late Pick-Up:** There is a \$2 per minute charge for picking up your child (ren) past their scheduled time.
- Transfer /Refunds:** No transfer policy due to very limited enrollment space. Camps will be based on a 1<sup>st</sup> come and 1<sup>st</sup> serve policy. **Refunds** there will be no refunds unless the City must cancel because we cannot staff, or don't get the enrollment minimums. In which a full refund will be given.
- Electronics:** No electronics of any kind are allowed in our Camp Programs. Exception: is if you're required to have an electronics device for the camp you're signing up for. A child cell phones must stay in the backpack too. The City of Hercules is not liable for lost, broken or stolen items.
- Attendance Policy:** If your child is absent one or more days of Camp during a week that you have made payment, you will not receive a refund. **We do not allow make-up days or give credits for missed camp days.**
- Children with Special Needs:** All children are welcome but your child cannot require one-on-one attention. Prior to enrollment, you need to contact the Recreation Manager to discuss the appropriateness of the child's placement. Note we must stay within the ratio guidelines at all times.
- Health Matters:** We will be following all of the Health Department requirements including daily temperature checks, frequent hand sanitizing, staff wear masks, children must have a mask at all times, etc. You agree to a complete health screening of your child before coming to the program. See New Safety Protocols for COVID-19 in the Parent Handbook.
- This is a **Recreation program** as defined by the State, are exempt from licensing requirements but it is mandated that Parents/guardians of children registered for recreation program be notified.



By signing below you understand that is a Recreation program not a licensed childcare facility.
