Identity Theft/Forgery: On September 2, 2020, at approximately 11:33 am, HPD Officers were dispatched to US Bank, inside Lucky, for a fraud in progress. There was a 45 year old female, at the counter of the bank, attempting to deposit checks. The identification she provided, to the clerk, did not match the information for the account holder. Officers arrived and contacted the female and detained her. The subject was found to be on felony probation, in Alameda County, for Burglary. She was in possession of three different persons' identification. She also had checks, from different companies, with the names of the persons' whose identifications she had in her possession. The victims were contacted and did not know the subject and wanted prosecution. The subject was arrested and transported to to the Martinez Detention Facility.
