Auto Burglary: On September 8, 2020 at approximately 9:57am hours, an officer responded to Valley Bible for a vehicle burglary that occurred September 6, 2020. The take was a golf cart battery.

Estes Robbery – In Custody: On September 8, 2020 at 7:11 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to Home Depot, 1625 Sycamore Ave. for a report of a subject brandishing a knife that just occurred. The reporting party said an unknown male, wearing a black shirt and black hat, just fled towards the parking lot. Officers located a 28 year old male, of Richmond, in the parking lot near the Home Depot Nursery. The subject matched the description of the suspect. The subject was detained. A knife, in a scabbard, was found tucked in his waistband. Officers met with a Home Depot Loss Prevention agent who stated the subject entered the store and purchased several items. The subject took his purchased items and retrieved a shopping cart which he took back towards the tool isles. The subject selected a Smart Home System and an Air Compressor (*Totaling \$429.00*) placing both items in the shopping cart, with his purchased items. The subject pushed the shopping cart, with the stolen items, outside where he was contacted by the Loss Prevention agent. The subject pulled out a knife and pointed it at the Loss Prevention agent and made threatening statements. The Loss Prevention agent then backed off and called 911. The Loss Prevention agent signed a complainant's arrest form and desired prosecution. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Prisoner Transport: On September 8, 2020 at 11:00 p.m. An Officer went to Santa Rita Jail, Alameda County Sheriff's Office and picked-up 60 year old male, of El Cerrito, on a Hercules outstanding Felony No Bail Warrant from 2013. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Hit and Run Vehicle Collision: On September 9, 2020 at 1:04 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of Violet Rd. for a hit and run vehicle. The reporting party stated an unknown suspect just collided into the driver's side of her a parked Gray '06 Honda Accord. The reporting party stated the unknown suspect's front bumper with license plate was left at the scene of the collision. The reporting party last saw the unknown suspect driving away up Violet Rd. past Iris Rd. The suspect vehicle was determined to be a Silver '14 Toyota Corolla. Officers arrived in the area, but didn't locate the Corolla.

Vandalism: On September 9, 2020 at 1:37 a.m. An Officer was dispatched to the parking lot of McDonald's, 1570 Sycamore Ave. for McDonald's employee who stated someone tried to shoot out their vehicle's windows. Upon arrival, the Officer located a Silver '97 Toyota 4-Runner with both the passenger side windows damaged. The Officer didn't find any evidence to support that the windows were shot with any projectile. It appears as if the unknown suspect used a blunt force object to strike both windows causing them to be cracked, but not shattered. The vandalism occurred sometime between 5:00 p.m. and the time of call.

Warrant Arrest: On September 9, 2020 at 2:00 a.m. An Officer checked on an occupied suspicious Black '07 Infiniti M35 parked on the E/B SR-4 Cummings Skyway off-ramp. The M35 was occupied by 24 year old male, of Vallejo. The subject was found to have an outstanding cite releasable Misdemeanor Warrant out of L.A.S.D. – Pico Rivera. The Warrant was issued on 07/29/2020. The subject was cited and released.
