## WATCH COMMANDER'S SHIFT REPORT

**Natural Death:** On September 16, 2020 at 9:45 am, an officer was dispatched to a residence on Poplar Ct. for the reported natural death.

**Warrant Arrest X2:** On September 16, 2020 at 11:31 am, Officers were dispatched to the area of the Bart Transit Lot at 1375 Willow Ave. The reporting party stated a male just pushed over another male. Both parties had left the scene prior to Officers arrival. While responding, two officers located the suspect who was found to have two misdemeanor warrants. The subject was cited for his warrants and BART PD took over the investigation.

**Found Property:** At 7:39 PM, a Hercules resident reported found property at Bristol/Weymouth near the hillside parking. An Officer collected a several suitcases with clothes, mail, checks, and miscellaneous wallet cards for safekeeping. He identified three owners and returned the property.

**Found Property:** At 5:00 AM, a citizen called in a BMX bicycle was found in the middle of San Pablo Ave/Sycamore Ave. An Officer collected the bicycle for safekeeping - owner unknown.

**Occupied Stolen Vehicle:** On September 17, 2020 at 1:08 pm, a resident called to report a suspicious vehicle parked in the 100 block of Grenadine Way. The vehicle was a 2016 Gray Toyota Tundra. The Tundra had been reported stolen out of Martinez today. The vehicle left the area prior to Officers arrival. Officers located the vehicle on Refugio Valley Rd. A stop was conducted on Sycamore near Willow Ave. The Tundra was released to the owner. The 35 year old female driver, out of Richmond, was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The jail declined to receive the subject and she was sent to the County Regional Medical Center, for Medical issues. The subject was released at the hospital and the case will be sent to the District Attorney's Office.

**Hit and Run:** On September 17, 2020 at 5:28 pm, and officer was dispatched to the Lucky Parking Lot at 1590 Sycamore Ave for a hit and run. The victim stated he was sitting in his vehicle when a green SUV was leaving and hit his vehicle. There was very slight damage to the victims BMW and it appears the other party may not have known he hit the victim vehicle.

**Towed Vehicle for Spinning Donuts:** On September 17, 2020 at 6:43 pm, officers were on a call, on Redwood Rd, when a subject decided to start spinning donuts at Redwood Rd. and Walnut. A traffic stop was made on the Silver G35 Infinity and the 19 year old driver, of Hercules, was cited for reckless driving. His vehicle was towed with a 30 day hold.

**Found Property:** On September 18, 2020 at 7:39 am, Home Depot called to report a found wallet at the business. The officer attempted to contact the owner but there was no answer. The wallet and contents were place into evidence.

**Identity Theft:** On September 18, 2020 at 2:03 pm, an officer was dispatched to the 400 block of Devonwood for an Identity Theft Report. The victim stated an unknown suspect used her Identity to get medical assistance and the victim received a bill for it.

**Warrant Arrest:** On September 18, 2020 at 2:35 pm, and Officers were dispatched to the area of the UPS store for an intoxicated subject. Officer arrived and contacted a 51 year old male, out of Rodeo. The subject did not appear to be intoxicated but had a cite releasable warrant out for his arrest. The subject was arrested and issued a citation, with a new court date, and released at the scene.

**Stolen Vehicle:** On September 18, 2020 at 4:16 pm an officer was dispatched to the 1600 block of Sycamore Ave, Home Depot, for the report of a stolen Vehicle. The vehicle is a 2006 Ford Box truck with RVO Rooter on the side.

**Warrant Arrest x 2:** On September 18, 2020 at 10:46 p.m. An Officer did a traffic stop on a Black '00 Mercedes for vehicle code violations. The 28 year old male driver, of Vallejo, was found to have two outstanding cite releasable Misdemeanor Warrants. The first, was out of Alameda County Sheriff's Office, issued on July 07, 2020. The second, was out of BART PD, issued on October 23, 2019. The subject was arrested, cited, and released on both Warrants.

**Possession of a controlled substance:** On September 19, 2020 at 4:02 a.m. An Officer did a traffic stop on a Blue '99 Toyota Corolla for vehicle code violations. The 60 year old male driver was from Rodeo. The 49 year old female passenger, of Martinez, was found to be on Felony Probation with a search clause. A search was done, and an officer found a small Ziploc plastic baggie, containing a substance suspected to be narcotics, in the subject's purse. The subject was arrested then cited and released.

**Auto Burglary:** On September 19, 2020 at 7:56 am, the resident from the 100 block of Canterbury called to report the toolbox in his 2019 Chevy Silverado was broken into sometime overnight. A safety construction harness was stolen.

**Package Theft:** On September 19, 2020 at 8:11 am and officer was dispatched to the 500 block of Athena for a package theft. The victim stated yesterday a package was stolen off her porch.

**Domestic Dispute:** On September 19, 2020 at 10:09 am, officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of Willow Ave for the report of a domestic dispute. Officers determined there was only a verbal altercation that had occurred near Mariner's Pointe. During the verbal altercation, between a 35 year old male and 36 year old female, the male left with their young child. The male was contacted, and officers facilitated a civil standby for the male to return the child, get his belongings, and leave the residence. A case was taken for documentation.

**Theft:** On September 19, 2020 at 5:44 pm, an officer was dispatched to the 500 block of Athena for a theft of passports. The passports were delivered to the house and the package with the passports was stolen.

**Outside Assist – Sideshow activity:** On September 19, 2020 at 11:33 p.m. Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office requested an outside assist for a large number of vehicles conducting an illegal sideshow in the parking lot of the Dead Fish Restaurant, 20050 San Pablo Ave. in Crockett. Hercules Officers, along with CCCSO Deputies, and CHP Officers were able to get the large number of vehicles to leave. Most of those vehicles then travelled to Richmond.

Some of the vehicles drove to Willow Ave. in Hercules. Hercules Officers spent the next hour monitoring the city for any of the vehicles from the group that left the Dead Fish Restaurant.

**Fraud:** On September 20, 2020, an Officer created a case for a fraud which was reported on September 18, 2020. The Hercules resident reported her "Stimulus" Check was cashed, but she never received the check in the mail. The Officer received a copy of the check, and it was signed with another name, and deposited through mobile banking. The Officer is conducting follow up to try to locate the suspect.

**Warrant Arrest x 2:** On September 21, 2020 at 12:40 a.m. An Officer did a traffic stop on a Blue '98 Ford Ranger for vehicle code violations. The 36 year old male driver was found to have two cite releasable Warrants. The first, was out of Nevada County Sheriff's Office, issued on January 10, 2020. The second, was out of Solano County Sheriff's Office, issued on March 17, 2020. The subject. was cited and released on both Warrants
