Online Report (Bob Cop) Identity Theft: On January 8, 2018, an Officer handled an online report for an identity theft. Sometime between January 1, 2017, and April 30, 2017, an unknown person opened a PG&E account for a residence in Vallejo using the reporting party's personal information.

Armed Robbery/Assault with a Deadly Weapon: On January 8, 2018 at approximately 12:35PM Hercules Officers were dispatched to an armed robbery, which just occurred. The location of the incident was inside the Starbucks, 842 Willow Ave. The suspects were described as two African Americana adults; wearing dark clothing; and armed with a small handgun. They were last seen running toward a residential area, to the rear of the shopping center. There were three adult male victims. The victims were customers, of Starbucks, and did not know each other. One of victim's was hit in the face with the gun. That victim was transported to a hospital with nonlife threatening injuries. The loss was electronic devices. The investigation is ongoing.

Mental Health Evaluation On January 8, 2018 at approximately 5:15PM HPD Officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Rock Harbor Point. A 15 year old male called 911 stating he had taken a number of pills. The juvenile was determined to meet the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. He was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

Commercial burglary: On January 9, 2018 at 1:30 am, Officers responded to Cricket Wireless located at 844 Willow Ave for a front door alarm. Officers found a large rock in front of the front door. The front door glass was shattered and the door was unlocked. No suspects were located inside the business. The loss is unknown at this time.
