**Missing Person:** On January 4, 2018 at 5:42pm, an officer was dispatched to HPD for a phone detail. The reporting party said her 40 year old female partner had not been seen or heard from since 9:93am this morning. The Missing Person was supposed to see her doctor this morning but did not keep the appointment. The missing person, and her vehicle, was entered into Missing and Unidentified Persons System. A Critical Reach flyer was disseminated. At 8:05pm officers were notified the subject was located, with a family member, in Southern California. The subject was removed from the Missing and Unidentified Persons System.

**Mental Health Evaluation:** On January 5, 2018 at 3:42pm, officers were dispatched to the 2200 block of Lupine for a mental health evaluation. Officers contacted a 39 year old male inside the residence. It was determined the subject met the criteria for Mental Health Evaluation. He was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

**Petty Theft:** On January 5, 2018 at 4:31pm, an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Cypress for the theft report. The reporting party said, today at 3:06pm, an unknown suspect was captured via home surveillance video, stealing packages from their front porch.

**Mental Health Evaluation:** On January 5, 2018 at 5:36pm, officers were dispatched to the 200 block of Glenwood for a mental health evaluation. Officers contacted a 32 year old female, inside the residence. It was later determined she had hurt herself. The subject met the criteria for a Mental

Health Evaluation. She was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

**Residential Burglary:** On January 5, 2018 at 9:53 pm officers were dispatched to an alarm in the 1000 block of Crepe Myrtle Dr. Officers contacted the homeowner's brother who requested officers check the residence. Officers located a broken kitchen window, over the sink. It also appeared that there was ransacking in the master bedroom.

**Warrant Arrest:** On January 6, 2018 at 3:18 am an officer conducted a traffic stop, on a black Toyota truck, for a vehicle code violation. The 25 year old driver, out of Vallejo, had three outstanding warrants from Contra Costa, Solano, and Sonoma County. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Lost Property:** On January 6, 2018 an officer took a case for a lost cellphone. The reporting party thinks he lost his cellphone while vacationing in SoCal.

**Found Property:** On January 6, 2018, an officer located property in the 3600 block of San Pablo Ave. that belonged to a known transient. The property was booked into safekeeping.

**Cold Traffic Collision:** On January 6, 2018, an officer was dispatched to HPD for a phone detail. The reporting party wanted to report a hit and run collision that occurred on December 28, 2017. It was determined that the other party was contacted on the 28<sup>th</sup>. Both parties were contacted and gave their accounts

**Non-Injury Collision/Vehicle vs Bicyclist:** On January 6, 2018 at 3:57pm, officers were dispatched to Sycamore Ave and San Pablo Ave for a report of a traffic collision. The 47 year old female bicyclist was in the crosswalk of San Pablo Ave when she was struck, by an adult driver of a motor vehicle, turning right onto San Pablo from Sycamore Ave. There was no complaint of pain from the bicyclist, nor visible signs of injury. The driver remained at the scene and cooperated with the investigation.

**Mental Health Evaluation:** On January 7, at 12:29 am, a 32 year old male Transient flagged down an Officer, at Willow near Hawthorne, to ask for assistance. The subject was soaking wet after having been in the creek and with the temperature at 40-42 degrees F. He appeared disoriented and unable to care for himself. He was determined to meet the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. He was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

**Warrant Arrest:** On January 7, 2018, at approximately 2:38 pm, an Officer conducted a traffic stop on a blue Toyota Matrix, with obstructed plates, in the parking lot of Lucky located at 1590 Sycamore Avenue. The front right, 31 year old male, passenger ran from the car and was later apprehended. The subject had an outstanding no cite felony warrant from CCCSO. The female driver drove out of the parking lot, and was last seen driving west on Sycamore towards San Pablo Avenue. Some merchandise, from Home Depot, was located in the parking lot where subject first got out of the car. The property was returned to Home Depot. The subject was arrested for the warrant, and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
