Auto Burglaries: On January 9, 2018, at approximately 7:52am, an Officer was dispatched to 200 block of Newbury Street for the report of two auto burglaries. Sometime between January 8, 2018, at 9:00pm, and January 9, 2018, at 6:30am an unknown person burglarized two vehicles belonging to the same victim. The vehicles were a 2001 Dodge pick-up, and a 2005, Chevrolet Cargo Van. Both vehicles had windows smashed and the loss was tools.

Attempt Residential Burglary: On January 9, 2018, at approximately 9:56am, HPD Officers were dispatched to the 500 block of Rosewood Lane for the report of someone breaking the rear window to the residence. A couple of minutes before the window was broken the reporting party said an African American male; in his 20's; wearing a gray hooded sweat shirt; was ringing her front doorbell and knocking on the front door. The reporting party heard the rear glass break, and went to the back of the house. She saw an African American male; in his 20's; wearing black pants, with a white stripe; but is not sure if it was the same person she saw in the front yard. The suspect did not make entry. The reporting party yelled at the suspect, making sure he knew someone was in the house. Officers were not successful in locating the suspect in the area.

Possession of Controlled Substance/Drug Paraphernalia/Probation Violation: On January 9, 2018, at 9:28am, an Officer checked on an occupied suspicious vehicle in the 100 block of Wadi Run. The Officer contacted a 38 year old female sitting in the vehicle. The subject was on searchable probation in Contra Costa County. A search was conducted

and the Officer located a substance believed to be a narcotic, and a glass pipe used to smoke narcotics, on her person. The subject was arrested for Possession of a Controlled Substance, Possession of Paraphernalia, and Probation Violation. She was issued a citation, and released.

Petty Theft from a Vehicle: On January 9, 2018, at approximately 2:19pm an Officer responded to the 700 block of Alfred Nobel for a report of vehicle tampering. The Officer was advised, on January 7 at approximately 9:19am, an unknown suspect took the battery from a 2012 ice cream truck. The truck was parked the parking lot.

Public Intoxication: On January 9, 2018, at approximately 4:09pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to the 900 block of Valley Run for a male lying on the sidewalk. Officers located a 57 year old male. The subject displayed objective signs of alcohol intoxication. The subject was unable to care for himself, and he was arrested for Public Intoxication. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.
