Located Missing Person: On February 6, 2018, at 7:41am, officers responded to the 100 block of Beryl Ct on a suspicious white van. The vehicle was occupied by three adult males. One of the subjects, a 33 year old male, was listed as a missing person from South San Francisco. The subject did not appear to be in distress. His name was removed from the Missing and Unidentified Persons System. The vehicle's registration had been expired for over six months. The vehicle was towed. The subjects were given a courtesy ride to the BART transit lot.

Shoplifting: On February 6, 2018, at 1:30pmm officers were dispatched to the Rite Aid for a theft in progress. The Caucasian female suspect, carrying a multi colored bag, had left the store. She was last seen walking towards the Lucky Market. An officer observed a female subject, matching the description, leaving the Lucky lot. The officer stopped the 27 year old female, but she did not have the bag. The witness was taken to the subject's location and positively identified the subject as the thief. The bag, with the stolen property, was located in the Lucky Shopping Center area. The suspect was issued a citation and released.

Hit and Run (Bob-Cop Report): On February 6, 2018, at 4:30pm, and officer accepted an online report regarding a hit and run. The incident occurred in the 1900 block of Lupine Rd, between 6:30am and 12:30pm, today. The reporting party's vehicle was struck from behind and sustained back fender damage.

Unauthorized use of an access card On February 6th 2018 at approximately 7:45PM a Rodeo resident came to HPD to report an unknown suspect(s) withdrew money from her Bank of America savings account. She stated the withdrawal was from the ATM, Hercules branch, on January 9, 2018 and February 4, 2018.

Lost Property On February 6th 2018 at approximately 8:02PM a HPD Officer was dispatched to the 400 block of Turquoise Dr for a lost property report. The reporting party said she last saw her green tote bag at Lucky at approximately 5:00PM. The bag contained her credit card and CDL. An area check was conducted but the missing property was not located.

Suspended DL/ Warrant Arrest/ Possession of a Controlled Substance/ Possession of Drug Paraphernalia/ Violation of Probation: On February 6th 2018 at approximately 11:42PM a HPD Officer conducted a traffic stop on a gray 2007 VW Jetta. The 39 year old male driver, of Richmond had a suspended Driver's License. He was cited/released at the scene, and his vehicle was towed. A 22 year old female passenger, of Richmond, had a no bail warrant held by San Pablo PD. She was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. A second passenger, a 38 year old male from Richmond, was determined to be on searchable Felony Probation. During a probation search the officer found substances, believed to be narcotics; and various items of narcotic paraphernalia. The male was arrested and transported to Martinez Detention Facility.
