Grand theft: On February 21, 2018 at 10:59 am, a HPD detective was flagged down regarding a theft of a purse from a vehicle. The vehicle was parked in front of Willow Food and Liquors, 844 Willow Ave, at approximately 10:15 am. An officer responded and took the report.

Vandalism: On February 21 at 11:37 am, a Pinole resident came to HPD to report a hit and run to his vehicle that occurred yesterday at the Lucky parking lot located at 1590 Sycamore Ave. The officer inspected the damage to his vehicle and suspected that it was most likely caused by a shopping cart and not a vehicle so a vandalism report was taken.

Possible Stalking: On February 21, 2018 at 12:05 pm, an Officer contacted a Hercules resident, at HPD, regarding an adult male subject who has been contacting her on Facebook messenger and at her workplace in Hercules. The contact is unwanted and the resident wanted it documented.

Debit card fraud(Bobcop): On February 21, 2018 at 1:44 pm, an Oakland resident reported debit card fraud that occurred at the Hercules Rite Aid Pharmacy yesterday located at 1560 Sycamore Ave. The resident still had possession of his card and is unsure how his card information was compromised.

Stolen vehicle recovery: On February 21, 2018 at 5:44pm, an Officer located the red Toyota truck, stolen from the Franklin Canyon Golf Course

on February 20, 2018, in the 1600 block of Sycamore. The front passenger door lock was punched out and the ignition was gone.

BobCop(On line Report): Sometime between January 24, 2018, at 3:55 pm, and January 25, 2018 at 3:55 pm, an unknown person attempted to open three different credit accounts in reporting party's name. The reporting party has no idea how anyone got her information. The accounts were not successfully opened.

Possession Of Controlled Substance/Violation of Probation: On February 22, 2018 at 10:55am, an Officer contacted a 29 year old male, of El Cerrito. The subject was working on a Mustang to the rear of 828 Willow Ave. The Officer observed the registration, of the vehicle was expired. The subject was on searchable probation out of Contra Costa County. During a probation compliance search the subject advised he had a pipe, commonly used to smoke narcotics; and some "cocaine" in the Mustang. The Officer located the pipe in the driver's side door panel. He located a white powdery substance, the subject said was cocaine, in the back left passenger floor board in a plastic container. The subject was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Burglary: On February 22, 2018 at 3:03pm, an officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Bluebird for a report of a burglary. The reporting party said between February 10, 2018 and time of call, an unknown suspect forced entry into her locked shed and stole power tools, landscaping tools and cooper.
