Auto Burglary: On February 13, 2018 at 7:49 AM, an officer was flagged down on Bristol @ Windsor. The reporting party stated, between February 12th at 7:00pm and February 13th at 7:4am, her 2004 Mitsubishi Galant was broken into while parked on Bristol. The suspect(s) broke the front passenger side window and stole a black colored diaper bag.

Auto Burglary: On February 13, 2018 at 7:27 AM, an Officer was dispatched to the 1200 block of Willow Ave., for a reported auto burglary. The reporting party stated the rear driver's side window, of her Infinity QX4, was broken. Unknown suspect(s) stole her work backpack which contained an HP computer. The incident occurred between February 12, 2018 at 5:00pm and February 13, 2018 at 7:15am.

Auto Burglary: On February 13, 2018 at 9:22 AM, an officer was dispatched to the 1000 block of Taraya Terrace for a reported auto burglary. The reporting party stated, between February 12, 2018 at 6:00pm, and February 13, 2018 at 8:30am, an unknown suspect/s smashed his front passenger window of his Chevrolet and stole a black laptop bag and an IPAD.

NOTE: The above three burglary reports are related to the four cases taken, in the same area, on February 12, 2018, at approximately 10:30pm. Four male juveniles were arrested.

Vehicle Tampering: On February 13, 2018 at 12:21 PM, an officer was dispatched to the Home Depot parking lot for a vehicle tampering incident.

The reporting party stated on February 13, 2018 between 10:00am and 12:15pm, an unknown person(s) punched out the locking mechanism his vehicles front door and gained access to the interior. Nothing appeared to be missing.

Stolen vehicle recovery: On February 12, 2018, an Officer located a Honda Civic, parked on Heather @ Aster. The vehicle was unoccupied with the engine running and the headlights on. A records check revealed the vehicle was not a reported stolen. An attempt was made to contact the owner with negative results. The officer secured the vehicle and turned the engine off. On February 13, 2018, Officers conducted another records check and learned the vehicle had been reported stolen to Daly City PD, sometime overnight. The vehicle was recovered and towed.

Stolen vehicle: On February 13, 2018 at 4:12pm, an officer was dispatched to the 1400 block of Willow Ave (Valley Bible church) for a reported stolen vehicle. The reporting party stated on she parked, and locked, her 1998 Dodge Ram at 7:21am. She was parked in the church parking lot. She later discovered her vehicle to be missing.

Mental Health evaluation: On February 13, 2018, Officers were dispatched to Crag Ct. for a possible overdose. Officers contacted 13 year old female, who stated she ingested pills. She later texted the crisis hotline. She was determined to meet the criteria for a Mental Health Evaluation. She was transported, by ambulance, to the County Regional Medical Center.

Shoplifting: On February 13, 2018 at 7:44 p.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched to a theft that just occurred at Rite Aid, 1560 Sycamore Ave. The reporting party stated four African American female adults just committed a theft and fled in an older White Lexus. Items stolen included baskets full of Chocolates and Valentines. The vehicle was last seen going towards Home Depot. A responding Officer saw a vehicle, matching the suspect vehicle description, entering Creekside Shopping Center. The Officer stopped a White '03 Infiniti I35 in the parking lot of Taco Bell. The Officer observed numerous boxes of Valentines chocolates and 4 cases (24 pack) of Modelo Beer. Officers detained a 37 year old female, of Richmond; a 24 year old female, of Richmond; a 27 year old female, of Richmond; and 19 year old female, of Vallejo. A Rite Aid employee positively identified all four suspects and wanted prosecution. All four suspects were arrested and later cited and released.

Warrant Arrest: On February 13, 2018 at 9:21 p.m. one of the officers, doing a follow-up on the above case, recognized a 43 year old male

standing in line at Rite Aid. The officer knew the subject had an outstanding Misdemeanor No Bail Warrant. The Warrant was confirmed, and the subject was arrested. The subject was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Located Missing Person: On February 14, 2018 at 12:45 a.m. Hercules Officers were dispatched the Hercules Post Officer for a report of a homeless person sleeping inside the lobby. Officers contacted an adult male Transient. The subject was reported as missing endangered person, at this time, to Richmond P.D, on January 18, 2018. The subject was not found to be endangered. He was removed from the Missing and Unidentified Persons System, and released.

BURGLARY: On February 14, 2018, at 10:13am, an School Resource Officer responded to the 2400 block of Refugio Valley Road for a burglary report. The reporting party said last Friday, February 9, 2018, between 7:45am and 3:30pm, someone removed cash from her purse. She had placed her purse in her desk drawer. The teacher was in and out of the class throughout the day and did not know who might have taken the money

Parole Search: On February 14, 2018 8:36am, HPD Officers, Investigators, and California Department of Corrections Parole Agents, went to the 100 block of Paradise Drive to conduct a parole search. The adult male subject was at home, and detained. During the search, of the residence, a handgun; a black ski-mask, and a window punch, were found. The subject was arrested for violating Parole, and Felon in Possession of a Firearm-. He was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Lost Property: On February 14, 2018, at approximately 8:00 pm, an Officer was dispatched to the 100 block of Violet Road for a cell phone which was lost earlier in the day. The phone was showing it was somewhere on Decatur Court in Hercules. The Officer contacted the Reporting Party who stated she lost her cell phone earlier in the day. The subject was able to use the Find my iPhone app and it showed her phone was somewhere near the 100 block of Decatur Court. Officers checked residences, in the area she thought she lost her wallet, but did not find it.

Possession of Controlled Substance/Warrant Arrest: On February 15, 2018, at approximately 2:30 am, an Officer contacted a 32 year old male, of Vallejo; and a 22 year old male, of Sacramento, in a 2017 Nissan in the parking lot of Jack in the Box. The Officer observed drug Paraphernalia in the vehicle, and subsequently searched the vehicle. A substance, believed to be a narcotic, was located in the vehicle. The 22 year old had an

outstanding felony warrant for Robbery. He was arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. The 32 year was arrested for possession of a Controlled Substance, issued a citation and released.

Suspected Mail Theft: On February 15, 2018 at 3:18pm, officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of Baywood regarding a theft of mail from a cluster of mailboxes. The reporting party said, about 15 minutes prior to calling the police, she saw two African American males, taking mail out of the clusters of mailboxes that belongs to her and three of her neighbors. The males are associated with an older silver pick-up, last seen eastbound on Baywood.

Robbery/Probation Violation: On February 15, 2018, at approximately 7:08 pm, HPD Officers were dispatched to the area of Refugio Valley Park for the report of a Robbery which just occurred. The suspect used a black handgun and took the 19 year old male victim's, wallet and cell phone. The suspect was described as an African American male juvenile; 5'3" to 5'4' tall; wearing a black hooded sweat shirt, and dark colored jeans. An Officer was able to determine, the victim's phone was in the area Tarn Court and Valley Run. An Officer located a male juvenile, walking on Country Run, matching the suspect's description. The subject was detained. A black BB gun pistol was found in his waist band. The victim positively identified the juvenile. The juvenile was arrested, and was transported to Juvenile Hall.

Court Order Violation: On January 16, 2018 at 10:51pm, an Officer stopped a maroon Chevy Malibu for a vehicle code violation. The driver was a 27 year old male, of Rodeo. The 17 year old female passenger was from Winters, CA. A records checked revealed a restraining order restraining the male from being with the female juvenile. The order was out of Yolo County. The male was subsequently arrested and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility. While being booked into, Deputies found a small amount of a substance, believed to be a narcotic, in the subject's boot. The juvenile was released and returned to Yolo County.

Auto Burglary: On February 16, 2018 at 4:33pm an officer was dispatched to Lucky for a report of an auto Burglary. The reporting party said while in Lucky shopping, an unknown suspect shattered a window of her vehicle and stole a backpack.

Warrant Arrest: On February 17, 2018, at approximately 3:34 am, an Officer contacted a 32 year old female, of Antioch, sitting in her 2000, Volkswagon Passat, at the Gas pump at Shell Gas Station. The female had a misdemeanor warrant out of Mendocino County SO. She was arrested for the warrant and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Possession/ Control Substance/Sales: On February 17, 2018 at 11:33am, an Officer initiated a traffic stop, on a blue Dodge Durango, for multiple CVC violations, at Willow Ave at Palm. The driver initially failed to yield and travelled approximately 1.1 miles before coming to a stop in the parking lot of Big Lots. While following the vehicle, the officer could see the driver moving around within the vehicle. The 50 year old Driver, of Vallejo, yielded but refused to cooperate with police. Officers were able to detain him. The Officer located syringes, and a small plastic baggie containing a white crystalline substance suspected to be a narcotic, on his person. During a search on the interior of the vehicle, the Officer located three more small plastic baggies, containing approximately the same amount, of a like substance, in each baggie. The Officer also located a small scale; and a package of multiple plastic baggies. The subject was arrested for possession of a controlled substance for sale and transported The Martinez Detention Facility.

Warrant Arrest: On February 18, 2018, at approximately 12:22 am, an Officer checked on a suspicious 2005, blue Audi A6 at the gas pumps at Shell Gas Station. The sole occupant of the vehicle, a 40 year female of Martinez, had a Felony Warrant held by Concord PD. The female was arrested, and transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

Attempt auto Burglary: On February 18, 2018 at 12:51 pm, the owner of a Ford Expedition called police. The reporting party said she was at Duck Pond Park, in the 900 block of Sycamore Ave, and observed two African American adults, in their 20s, smash the window of her vehicle. The suspects backed the white sedan, up next to her vehicle. The suspect vehicle was last seen heading EB on Sycamore towards SPA. Victim suffered no loss.

Auto burglary: On February 18, 2018 at 3:55pm, the owner of a 2018 VW SUV reported a window smash to his vehicle with a Dell Inspiron laptop computer stolen. The incident occurred in the 800 block of Willow Ave, between 11 am to 3:30 pm.

Suspicious Circumstance: On February 18, 2018 at 8:34 p.m. several callers reported hearing multiple gunshots in the area of Victoria Crescent East and Victoria Crescent West,. A specific area was not able to be determined and no evidence of gunshots was located.
