**Arrest:** On March 12, 2018 at 2:48 PM, an officer observed a suspicious vehicle parked to the rear of the UPS store (1500 Sycamore Ave). An adult male, was standing outside of the vehicle, and verbally identified himself. A second officer contacted a 43 year old female, of Sacramento, in the front seat passenger. The second officer observed a a substance, suspected to be a narcotic, on the center console of the vehicle. The female was removed from the vehicle and a pipe, commonly used to smoke narcotics, was found on her seat. Both subjects were arrested for Possession of a Controlled Substance, and Possession of Paraphernalia. Neither subject possessed hard ID. Both subjects were cite released in the field. Upon doing further investigation the officer determined the male subject had identified himself using his brother's name; and used the brother's name when he signed the citation for two Misdemeanors. The male subject was re-contacted. A records check revealed he had (5) out of county warrants. The 41 year old male was arrested for False Personation; and the outstanding warrants; in addition to the narcotic charges. He was transported to HPD. While in the interview room, the claimed to have blacked. AMR cleared him, medically, before he was transported to the Martinez Detention Facility.

**Residential Burglary:** On March 12, 2018 at 4:20 PM, a Hercules resident came to the HPD lobby to report a residential burglary in the 300 block of Lagoon. The incident occurred sometime between February 11, 2018 and March 11, 2018. The reporting party stated an unknown person may have used a lost garage door opened to gain access to his residence.
