

# HERCULES HAPPENINGS

This is a great time to be in Hercules! People often ask questions like, when will Safeway will be done, or what's happening with the Bayfront? So, we wanted to share some of the exciting happenings in Hercules.

## HERCULES DESIGNATED AS CANDIDATE RAIL STATION

Hercules received some big news in February 2020. The Capitol Corridor Joint Powers Authority Board designated Hercules' Regional Intermodal Transportation Center (RITC) as an official candidate station. This is an important step to help secure grant funding needed to complete the planned rail station and related improvements. The first three phases of the project, which sets the stage for rail service, have already been completed and were funded by a variety of Federal, State and local grants.

In addition to serving as a stop on the Capitol Corridor and San Joaquin routes, the transportation center will act as a central point for many vital transit options. The project also would provide an environmentally sustainable solution to addressing congestion on I-80. By reducing the number of cars and trucks on the road, it would contribute less air pollution, energy use, and fuel consumption.



## HERCULES DEVELOPMENT

The Waterfront District Master Plan guides the development of the Hercules Bayfront. The project will consist of nearly 1,500 residential units and just over 70,000 square feet of retail/office space, plus public and private amenities.



## THE VILLAGE

The eight blocks east of Refugio Creek comprise The Village. The Exchange (below) will have 172 residential units and 14,000 square feet of retail. The Exchange is scheduled to open in May 2020. Construction started in early 2019 on the Grand @ Bayfront, the second phase of the Bayfront, with 231 apartment units, with 15 affordable units, in a four story building on John Muir Parkway. The third phase of two additional buildings, the Warehouse @ Bayfront and the Annex @ Bayfront has been approved, and is in plan check, with an additional 473 residential units, with 25 affordable units, on three blocks.



## OTHER DEVELOPMENT IN THE CITY

The new Safeway at San Pablo and Sycamore is under construction with completion set for the last quarter of 2020. Muir Pointe on John Muir Parkway will see its final homes completed and occupied in early 2020. The approved Willow Avenue Center, which will feature an auto service park and self-storage, may be in construction in 2020.

Sycamore Crossing, which will feature a retail center, the City's first hotel (Hampton Inn & Suites), and a 120-unit residential condominium community. Construction will begin in 2020 on the site bound by San Pablo, Sycamore, and Tsushima. Also in early 2019, plans were submitted for a new residential community of up to 600 units on the Hilltown site which is at the corner of John Muir Parkway and San Pablo with planning commission and city council approval anticipated in spring 2020.

## LOOKING AHEAD AND STAYING CONNECTED

The City's highest priorities for the immediate future continue to be: 1) securing rail and ferry service and completing the Hercules Regional Intermodal Transportation Center; 2) facilitating the build-out of the Bayfront; 3) fostering commercial development to expand the City's revenue base; and, 4) Successfully resolving the City's remaining redevelopment dissolution issues.

### POOL RULES AND SAFETY INFORMATION

- Children 13 years & under must be accompanied by guardian 18 years or older.
- Swimsuits are required to enter the pool. No Cutoff shorts, basketball shorts, or street clothes.
- Only US coast Guard approved life vests may be worn, with adult supervision.
- No photograph or recording equipment allowed in the pool area or locker rooms.
- All persons not toilet-trained, including incontinence, must wear a swim diaper.



# AQUATICS

## LIFEGUARD TRAINING:

The lifeguard training course includes American Red Cross lifeguard training, CPR/Automated External Defibrillator (AED) for the professional rescuer, and First-aid certifications; all requirements needed to apply for a lifeguarding position.

### Prerequisites:

- Be at least 15 years of age on or before the last day of class.
- Swim 300 yards continuously
- Swim 20 yards front crawl, surface dive 7-10 feet, retrieve a 10-pound object, return to surface, swim 20 yards back to starting point with object and exit water without using ladder or steps, within 1 minute, 40 seconds.

- Must attend all classes
- Must complete all homework
- Must demonstrate competency in all required skills & activities
- Must demonstrate competency in final skill scenarios
- Correctly answer at 80% of the questions correctly in the final exams
